- 1 STUDY AT THE SLC**
 Located in the Cesar Chavez Student Center, open during the semester Monday - Thursday 8:00AM - 10:00PM and Friday 8:00AM - 5:00PM and longer for exams. Study in groups or independently and eat while doing it too.
- 2 TAKE AN ADJUNCT CLASS**
 Taken in addition to lecture and section, this 1-unit class boosts learning in multiple subjects including Math and Stats. Attend 1st class for the CCN.
- 3 DO A MOCK EXAM / EXAM REVIEW**
 Check your learning by taking a practice exam before the real test. Offered for multiple classes in Biology, Math, Stats, and Econ.
