Introduction





Important Recent Updates

- BIO has recently received some updated guidance from DHS!
- For F-1/J-1 purposes, you are considered a "new" student if you entered or will enter the U.S. with F-1 or J-1 Initial status with an I-20/DS-2019 start date for Fall 2021 or later. Basically-you are a New student in your first semester of entry!
- A "continuing" student for visa purposes is a student who entered the U.S. with F-1/J-1 status with I-20/DS-2019 start date for a prior semester (Summer 2021, Spring 2021, Fall 2020, etc). You are a *Continuing* student after your finish your first semester in the US.



New Student Guidance

- The default instructional mode for Fall 2021 will be primarily in-person and in general, all students are expected to be physically present on campus for Fall 2021.
- New or Initial F-1/J-1 students entering the US to begin studies in Fall 2021 must be enrolled in at least one course with in-person instructional mode. Berkeley's instructional model is primarily in-person, but it includes hybrid instruction as well.
- **Continuing F-1/J-1 students** who entered the US in a previous semester and were enrolled continuously are technically allowed fully remote instruction if needed, but most instruction will be in-person.



Late Arrival

Late Arrivals

- **First** contact your academic department to see what options are possible for you.
- BIO will work with students who face arrival difficulties for Fall 2021 to determine the best option for their specific circumstances, including advising on late arrivals, readmission and return after deferral/withdrawal, and how to receive updated I-20/DS-2019 documents.
- Please complete BIO's mandatory <u>Fall 2021 Arrival Survey</u> so that we can confirm your arrival date and any necessary I-20/DS-2019 adjustment
- If you urgently need an updated I-20 for a visa interview appointment prior to that time, please <u>contact us</u> and include a copy of your visa appointment confirmation.

Admissions Deferrals

- Newly admitted undergraduates will need to contact the <u>Office of Admissions</u> to determine if you have an option to defer to a future semester.
- Graduate students should also communicate with their academic department regarding any option to defer.



Arrival Support

- Our <u>COVID-19 website</u> has arrival letters for students entering in Fall 2021
- The letter states you can arrive up to 30 days *after* the start of your I-20/DS-2019 (if necessary)
- If you'll be arriving more than 30 days after the start of Your I-20/DS-2019, you need an updated I-20/DS-2019 and BIO will work with you on that.
- You MUST have the approval of your academic department for Late arrival
- No special notes or annotations are needed on the I-20 or DS-2019 regarding instructional models!




- DO NOT WORK without the correct work authorization! Learn more in our upcoming "Working in the US" session



- Proof of current or next semester's enrollment
- Evidence of current Financial Support
- Proof of <u>SEVIS Fee</u> payment
- Proof of post-completion employment and authorization*

* After graduation/program completion only



Travel & Entry Tips

- Don't bring restricted items to the U.S. (**bit.ly/CBPlist**)
- Be calm and answer any questions succinctly about your academic program and your activities in the U.S.
- Jokes about terrorism, breaking laws, drugs, etc. are never a wise choice.
- Be prepared in case of Secondary Inspection (bit.ly/CBP-SI)
- See the ACLU's Know Your Rights resources for Rights at Airports & Other Ports (aclu.org/know-your-rights)



Electronic Devices

- Customs & Border Protection may request to inspect your electronic devices. See bit.ly/ACLUdevices for tips on how to prepare your device before you travel.
- Are you presenting your best self in social media and messaging apps?
- How would you feel if U.S. immigration looked at all of your photos and messages?
- Is there any possibility it might appear that you are engaged in activities that violate U.S. laws or your visa status or that show academic dishonesty?





Attend the school noted on your I-20 (F-1s) or DS-2019 (J-1s)



Transferring SEVIS Record

Transfer IN = Must UC Berkeley I-20/DS-2019 & full-time study at UC Berkeley

Transfer OUT = Request I-20/DS-2019 transfer *to another school* for full-time study

Taking classes at another school while still at UCB: Concurrent enrollment classes at other schools will not count towards your full-time enrollment at UC Berkeley for visa purposes.



Completing your Program







Keep your I-20 or DS-2019 valid at all times and understand your completion date.

Grace Period



What is my Grace Period?

Your main goal on an F-1 or J-1 visa is to study. When you are finished with that, you will have some time to decide what to do next. This length of time is called a grace period.

F-1s have a 60 day grace period. J-1s have a 30 day grace period. but must take some actions before their DS-2019 program end date as outlined below.

Health Insurance



Insurance Requirements

Maintaining health insurance is a university requirement until graduation.

Federal immigration regulations require J-1/J-2 students to maintain proper health insurance meeting specific requirements throughout their J program, including period of post-completion employment.


