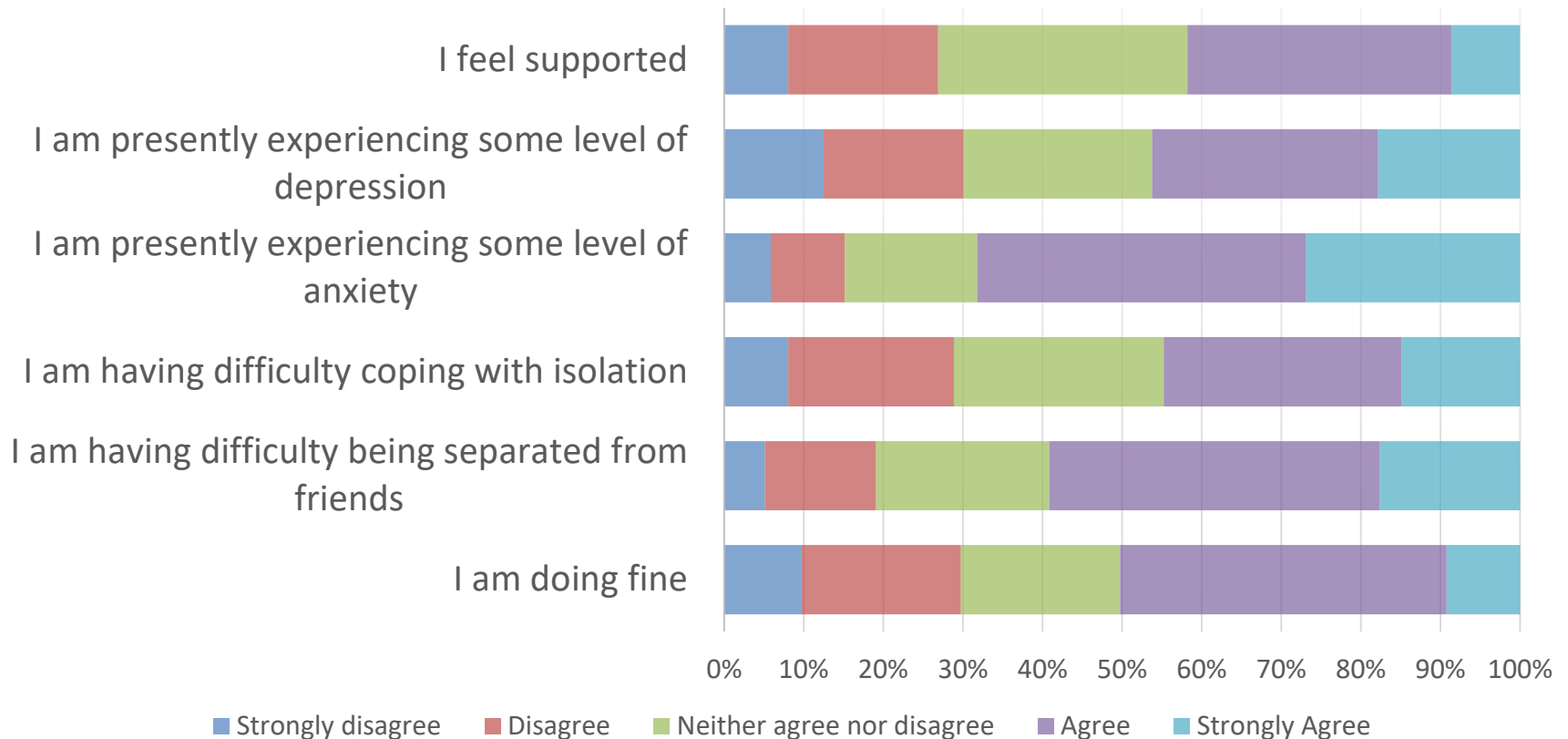

Admission & Enrollment of New Degree-Seeking International Students

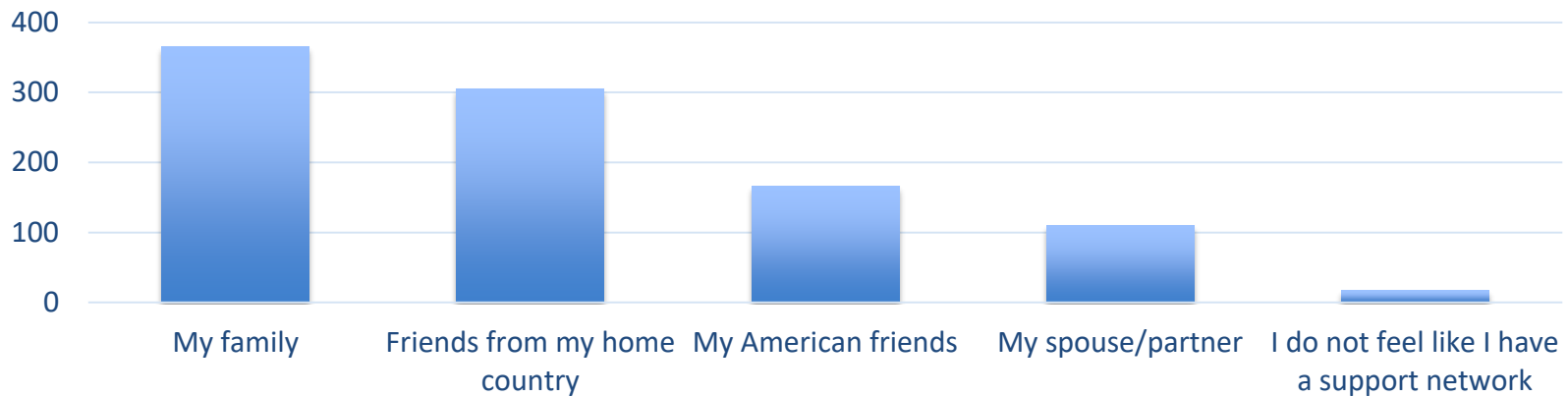

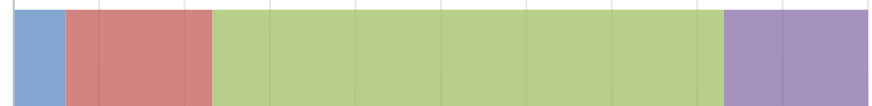
I am satisfied with how other campus services have supported my needs as an international student since the start of the pandemic.



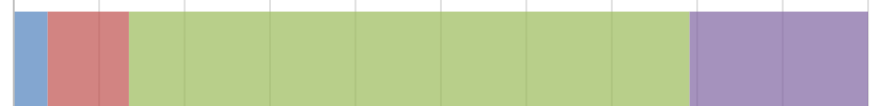
I am satisfied with how BIO has responded to my needs as an international student since the start of the pandemic.



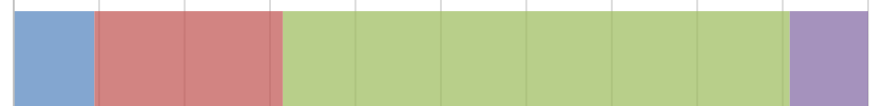
BIO has kept me sufficiently informed about other resources since the start of the pandemic.



BIO has kept me sufficiently informed about immigration matters since the start of the pandemic.



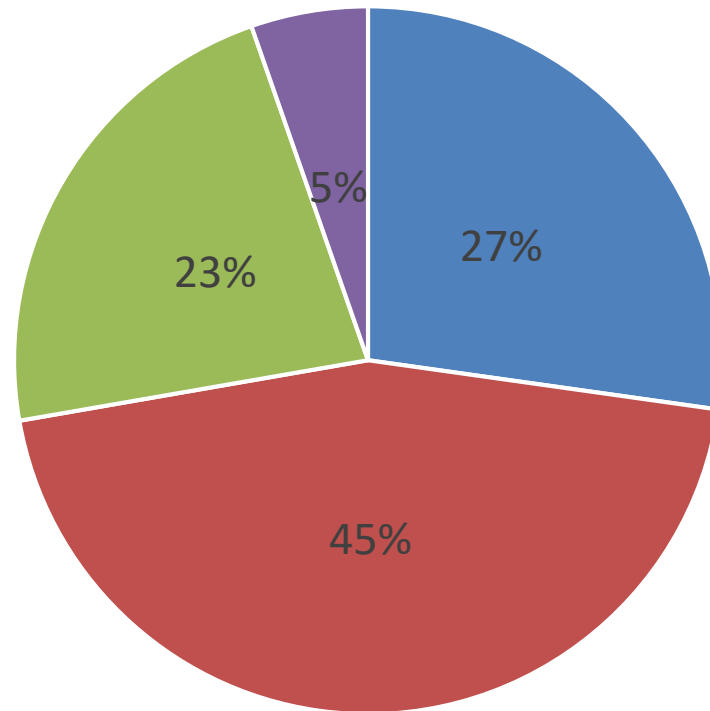
The resources available to me as a student are generally sufficient.
